

Internet Safety for Parents, Teachers & School Staff: 45 Min (Adults)

This presentation is to increase awareness and close the gap between the activities of pre-teens/teens on the internet. Kids sometimes have access to cyberbullying, chatting with strangers online, posting personal/sensitive information, or involvement in sexting/online sexual relationships simply because adults are not aware of the trends in which the teens are participating. This is meant to inform parents/teaching staff of red flags to look for in kids who may be involved in dangerous activity **online**.



Internet Safety for Teens and Pre-Teens: 45 Min (6th -12 Grades)

This presentation is meant to inform teens of the dangers of risky online behavior. It covers online predators, social media dangers, posting sensitive or personal information online, cyberbullying, sexting & many other dangers teens can encounter knowing by their actions via technology. This presentation includes videos for the teens.

Neighborhood Watch 60-90 Min (Adults)

primarily to prevent property crimes & increase your quality of life, **NW** has been an active program since the 1970's for one reason; because it **WORKS**. This in depth training covers 3 important aspects of NW. **1)** Neighbors organizing & coming together. **2)** How to detect suspicious activity, share it with one another proactively & report it to Law Enforcement. **3)** Techniques & trends to protect your property more effectively & reduce the window for opportunity for crime. The CP Unit will cover crime trends in your area, how to make a proper call for service, response time issues, vehicle theft, home security & everything in-between.



Personal Safety: 30 Min (Adults)

The best way not to become the victim of a crime or an accident is by preventing it from happening in the first place. This presentation reminds us to be prepared in any situation. Covering street precautions, vehicle/travel safety, home safety, office safety, bus safety - and what to do if you should become a victim. Our presentation tries to incorporate many different aspects of life.

Share the Road: Bike and Pedestrian Safety: 30 Min (All Ages)

Pedestrians & drivers do not always see eye to eye. It is important to remind & refresh the community on ways to be safe regardless of which route is taken. This presentation covers information for drivers, walkers & bicyclists alike. Additionally, a bike signal, bike reflector & bike helmet demo can be done at the end of the presentation.

Sheriff's Activities League 20 Min (All Ages)

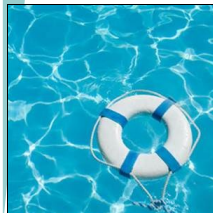
Stranger Danger 30 Min (K-4)

A presentation for young children meant to supplement & reinforce what parents should be teaching in the home. Stranger Danger alerts kids that not all bad people **LOOOK** bad - and uses examples that strangers may use to lure young children. "Good Strangers" or people to turn to in a time of need, videos engaging "what if" scenarios, as well as suggestions for parent/child passwords & how to call 911 & report to a safe adult are all covered in the basic presentation for younger aged children.

Senior Scams and Frauds:45 Min (Adults)

The goal of this program is to inform, protect, prevent & spread the word to educate our community on the crimes primarily fraudulent being targeted at Senior Citizens. The presentation uses statistics & data from Kern County Sheriff's Office Detectives to educate our community on some of the more popular scams & hoaxes being used to commit crimes against senior citizens.

Water Safety 45 Min (Adults)



This water safety presentation educates parents on the prevention of drowning and water related accidents. Statistics & risk factors for various age groups and the 3 main risk locations; home, pool & natural bodies of water are all covered. Tips for proper supervision, creating barriers & knowing the signs are also covered. At the end of this presentation, child heatstroke prevention is introduced, including a safety video & tips for parents to prevent this tragedy.

Is an outreach to the residents of Kern County in an effort to educate and inform our community how to stay safe and improve one's quality of life.

Presentations available for any organization in Kern County*:

Anti-Bullying Presentation 30 Min (K-5th Grade)

This power point presentation includes basic information for school age kids on the dangers of bullying & how to stop bullying in their school. It covers the different types of bullying among children, how to stand up to a bully, how to prevent bullying & what to do if YOU are or have been the bully. This presentation ends with a fun cartoon of McGruff the Crime Dog.

Crime Prevention Unit 20-30 Min (Teen-Adult)

"What exactly IS the Crime Prevention Unit and what services do you offer the public?" We take pleasure in talking about what we do by providing a fun slideshow of all the free services, charities, children's events and outreach efforts we offer to everyday people. This is a great presentation for quick lunch time meetings, for charitable organizations & community partnerships interested in the Crime Prevention Unit.

Crime Scenes & Fingerprints 45 Min (Ages 6-Adult)

This presentation covers crime scene evidence/ preservation & what really goes on when that yellow crime scene tape goes up. This also covers the various ways kids can help Law Enforcement by playing an active role in their community. The presentation ends with evidence collection techniques & information about fingerprints – complete with fingerprint lifting demonstration & cards to take home.

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) 45 Min (Adult)

Participants learn about how the design and use of the environment can control human/criminal behavior and reduce the fear of crime, crime prevention through natural means and how natural surveillance decreases the opportunity for crime.

Domestic Violence/ Teen Dating Abuse 45 Min (Teen-Adult)

These two presentations cover Domestic Violence & the different types of abuse, the link between DV & alcohol/drug abuse, warning signs, the cycle of abuse, the victims of DV & the resources available within our county for those needing to seek services. Many of the warning signs & indicators of an abusive relationship are visible early on in life when teens are first forming dating problems. We hope to make a difference in the lives of teens and adults through this presentation.

Drug Awareness for Parents 60 Min (Adults)



A program designed for parents, teachers or staff working with youth. Intended to focus on current drug trends & paraphernalia common among kids and teens. Symptomology and effects are also discussed.

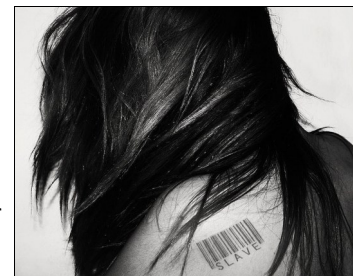


Hug-a-Tree Program 30 Min (Ages 5-12)

This educational program is presented by the Search & Rescue Team of the Kern County Sheriff's Office & is designed to teach children basic principles for staying safe in the wilderness. A curriculum originally created by Border Patrol Agent AB Taylor & renowned tracker Tom Jacobs, the program derives its name from its primary message: "If you are lost, stay put & hug a tree until help arrives." The Search & Rescue Staff can also provide coloring books & on special occasions the Search & Rescue canine may accompany the presentation.

Human Trafficking 45- 60 Min (College/Adults)

A presentation for all adult residents of Kern County. We bring awareness of both types of Human Trafficking, sex trafficking and labor trafficking. Risk factors, recruitment methods, indicators & local resources for help are all discussed and provided.



Identity Theft 30 Min (Adults)

Identity Theft is one of the fastest growing crimes in the US & costs Americans over 10 billion dollars every year. In this presentation, we cover many useful & practical tips to prevent being a victim of identity theft. We also present information for those who have been victims & the resources that are available to help.
